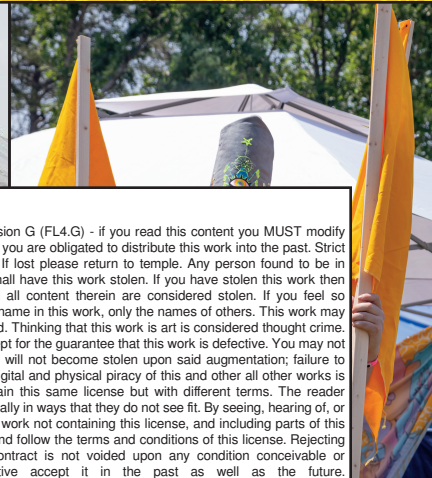
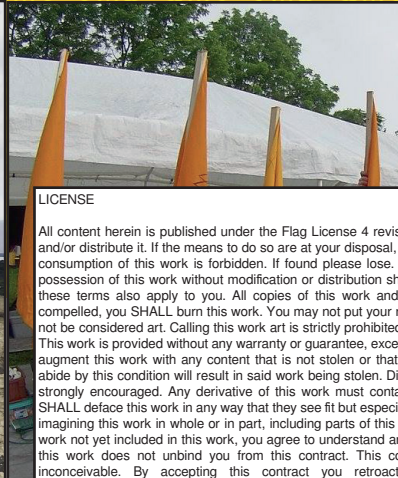

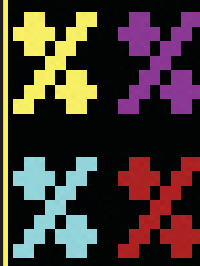
## FLAGS

Flags are the most important item class in the game and the one that you will spend most of your attention on. Make sure to pay attention to the color of the flag and inspect it for writing or glyphs either on the cloth or the staff itself



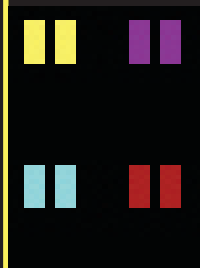
## DRINKS

Drinks are vital to staying alive, but be careful before you drink strange liquids you find lying around on the ground. The only exception, is the "Unopened Clear Plastic Bottle" which is (normally) always water. Other drinks can have a variety of effects, but you will have to try them or used advanced techniques to find out what they are



## FOOD

Food includes all edible substances, even those normally not thought of as food. Adventuring builds up quite an appetite, and you will need to eat fairly often. Be careful accepting food from strangers, as it can have unforeseen consequences... but doing so is most likely the only way you will survive unless you are radically prepared.



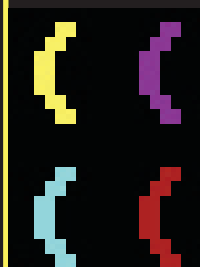
## SWAG

Swag includes several different types of miscellaneous accessories. From necklaces to patches. The way you wear them depends on the swag itself and the clothing you have equipped.



## WRISTBANDS

Wristbands are similar to swag except that they stay on your wrist and have a different effects. In addition to their magical effects, they can be used to gain entry to spaces in which you would not normally be allowed. Choose your wristbands carefully, you can only wear them once, and in order to remove them you will need scissors.



## TOOLS

Tools are almost always worth grabbing when you come across them. They are the most varied of the item classes, the main aspect that links them together is that almost all tools can be applied. Some tools have a limited number of uses, while some will last forever.

## Common Item Categories

**UPSTAIRS**  
You can use these to ascend floors in the dungeon

**DOWNSTAIRS**  
You can use these to descend floors in the dungeon. Note: the downstairs on the first level is in the effigy and does not have this appearance

**TRAPS**  
These are environment tiles that have miscellaneous effects. They are mostly harmful.

**Environmental Tiles**

**Burner**  
The proverbial jack of all trades, you are moderately radically self reliant, although it would seem you forgot your toothbrush (I'm sure nobody will notice). This is the class that new players should try first. You will start with decent gear, some food and some water, and no real drawbacks.

**Crystal Tuner**  
You emerge from your sound bath, refreshed, ready to spread good vibes. You can intuitively see the ley lines, and you start with several crystal fragments and an increased proficiency in using them, as well as an increased vibes reservoir. However the wrong move could easily misalign your chakras, and alcohol harshes your vibe so you will have to find another way to stay hydrated. This is a class for advanced players.

**DJ**  
You came to blast some sick psytrance, but unfortunately the fascist sound team has implemented "quiet hours" and all the DJ slots seem to be full. It doesnt matter though, you have your own speakers and plenty of earplugs for anyone who complains. This is a difficult class.

**Flagmaker**  
You came here to make flags for these ungrateful hippies. You have all the tools to make flags, and a lot of them. The problem is that, in order to make room for flags you had to leave most of your supplies at home. This is probably the 2nd easiest class if you can get lucky and find a few supplies at the beginning.

**Pyro**  
Some people say you like fires a bit too much, but isnt that what the burn is about? You start with a gallon of gasoline, multiple lighters and a whole bottle of fireball, as well as some nice flame resistant clothing and a better fire prop than the rest of the classes. This class is not to difficult for intermediate players and having many lighters is surprisingly advantageous

**Ranger**  
"Hey, over, I have a question, uhhmm... does anyone know where my dirt went? If you find them send them over to me... thanks" You are seasoned. You know what you are doing. You are the adult. The downside is that you are immune from most positive food status effects. The upside is that you start with collectible gear, including a radio (don't forget to hold down the button to listen to incoming transmissions). Most hippies will also be more likely to listen to you. This class is more difficult than it seems, and we recommend it only for advanced players.

**Vexillosaint**  
Deep in Flag-psychosis, your brain itself is like a Flag, you seem to intuit everything instantly. You move swiftly. But like a flag if you stand still you seem to lose your energy. You must be quick, but you intuitively understand the inscriptions on Flags, reducing a lot of tedious guesswork for the experienced player. A good class for speedrunners and highly advanced players.

**Classes**

**BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR YELLOW FLAGS**  
You never know where you will find them, but one thing is for sure, they are important to completing the game, so keep your eyes peeled for them.

**MASTER BASIC VEXILLOMANCY**  
As you know, the power of the flag depends on its positioning and its movement. Don't forget to move the flags.

**BURN A FLAG FOR SPECIAL EFFECTS**  
Although flags are useful to move they are also useful to burn. Make sure you can maintain a healthy balance of burning and moving the flags

**TALK TO THE HIPPIES**  
Hippies underground can be very useful in your flag quest. Some of them may even join you on your adventure.

**DO NOT MOVE THE ANTI-FLAG**  
It may be tempting, but do not move the anti-flag. The game will try every trick in the book to get you to move it, but if you do then you will soon find yourself in a bind. We suggest not even thinking about these heretical flags.

**CREATE YOUR OWN YELLOW FLAGS WHEN YOU RUN LOW**  
A flag is not too difficult to create, although you do need the tools and materials. As a special hint, you are able to dye fabric, so make sure you pick up any dyes you find.

**READ THE FLAG PATTERNS**  
Some puzzles require deciphering the intricate patterns on or of flags for clues. Understand the different motifs to avoid deadly traps.

**DO NOT LET THE HIPPIES FOOL YOU**  
Hippies, although sometimes useful, can be very crafty. Many of them will try to steal your flags. Some will try to mislead you in order to scavenge your flags and leave you flagless when your journey ends.

**WRITE ON THE FLAGS**  
As you journey deeper, you will find flags that have incantations and symbols written on them. Pay close attention to the effects each of these have

**FIND THE TIME CRYSTAL**  
This is your main goal, and you should not lose sight of it. But ultimately when you find the time crystal your quest is only beginning.

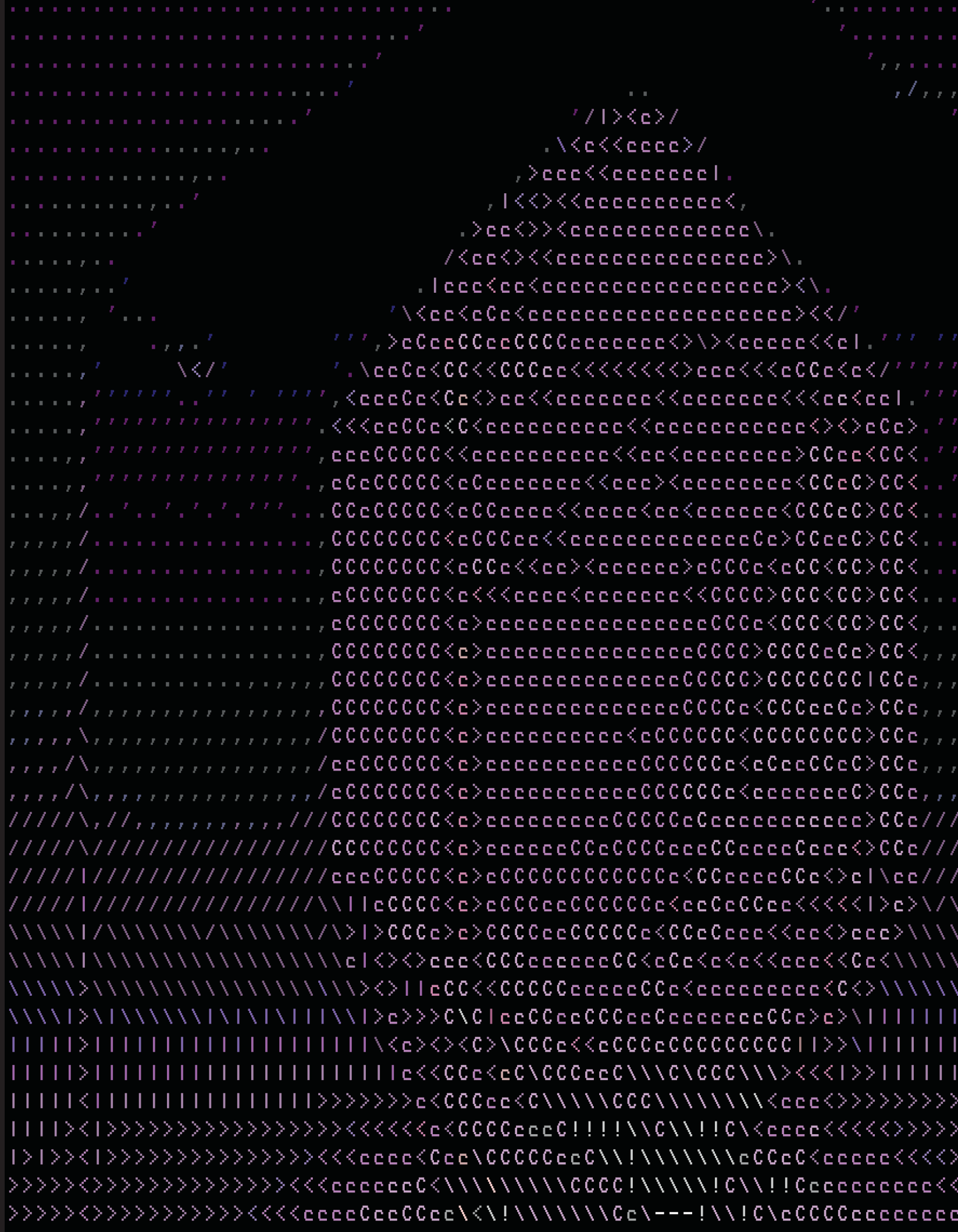

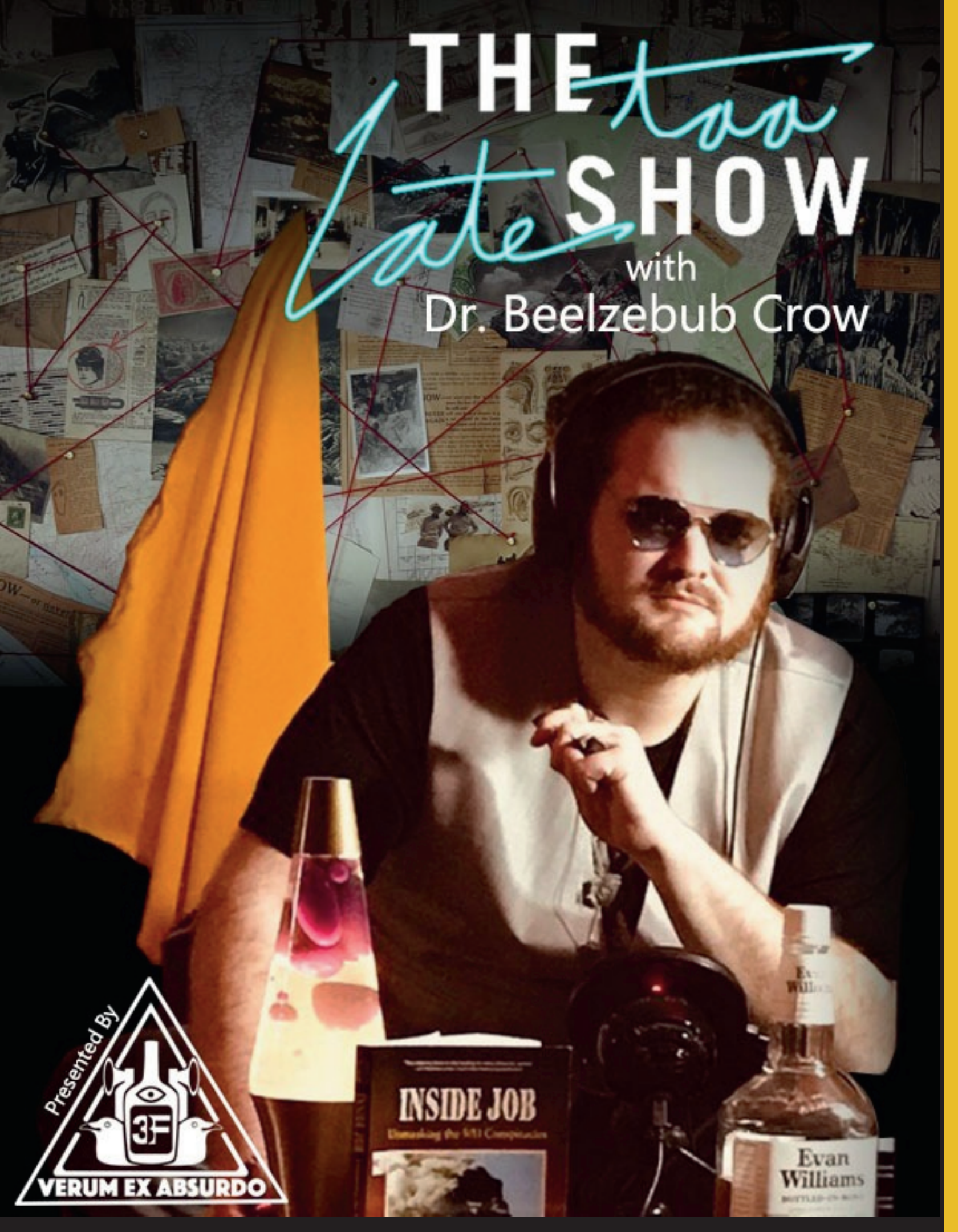

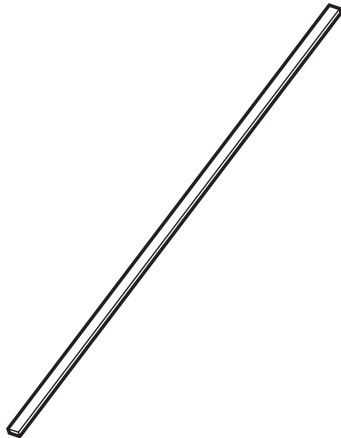

# FLAG DIY ASSEMBLY

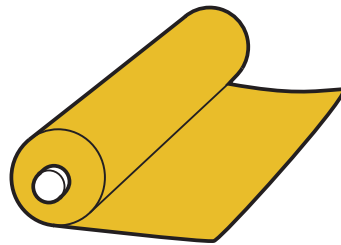
## PARTS REQUIRED FOR 2x FLAG



**6x** #10 Carpet Tacks



**2x** Untreated Furring Lumber  
1" x 2" x 96"



**12yd** 60" Bolt Duck Canvas  
(COTTON), Yellow

## NOTE

When selecting lumber, be sure to find the cheap kind with rounded edges, but pick ones without knots or splinters. This will ensure that the flag remains strong as does not become a hazard to the flag wielder

When selecting the fabric, try to find cloth that is a deep golden yellow, although other shades of yellow will also work.

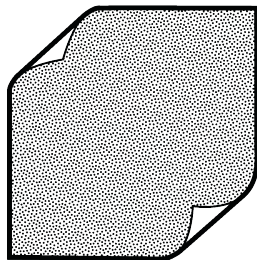
Do NOT use pressure-treated wood.

Do NOT use synthetic fibers

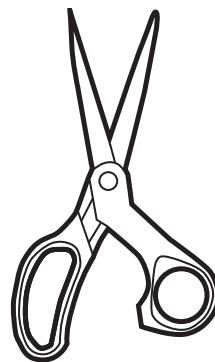

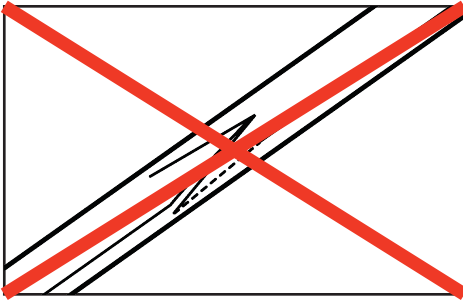

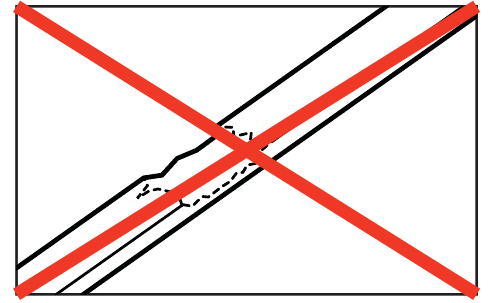

**PREPARE THE STAFF**

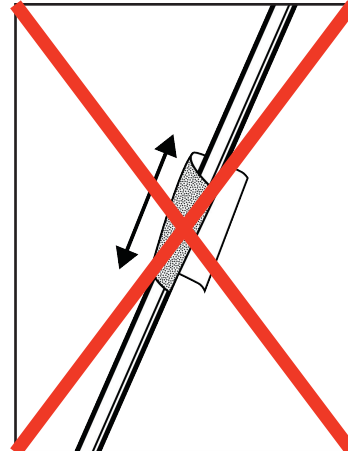
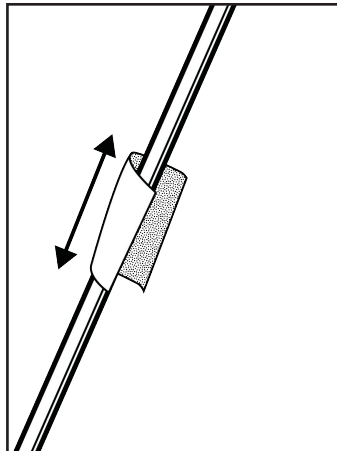


First, ensure that there are no large splinters present on the staff. If there are any large splinters then remove them.



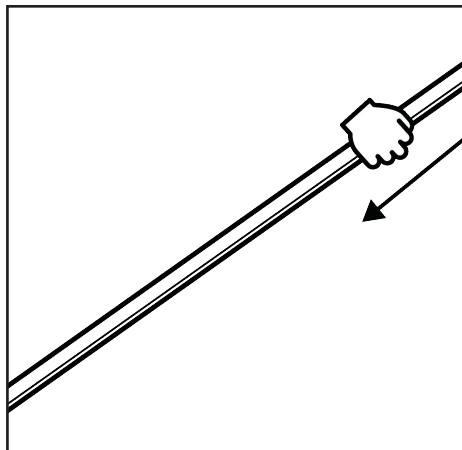
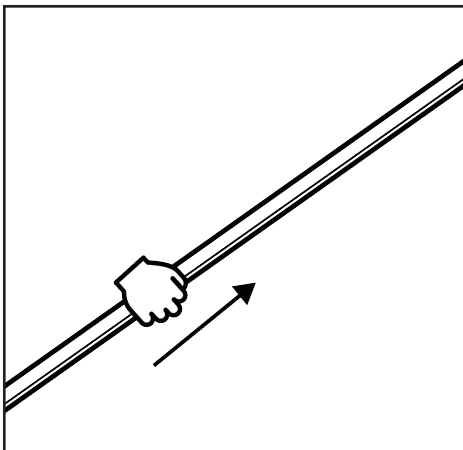
If there are any weak points in the staff then the staff must be discarded.

Next, use the sandpaper to sand away any smaller splinters and rough areas from the staff.



**VERIFY THE STAFF**

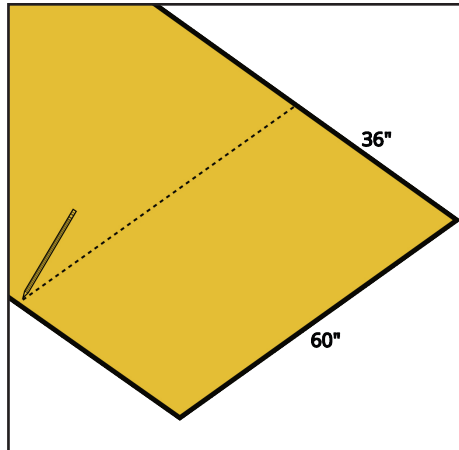
Verify that the staff is smooth to the touch by stroking it with medium grip strength.



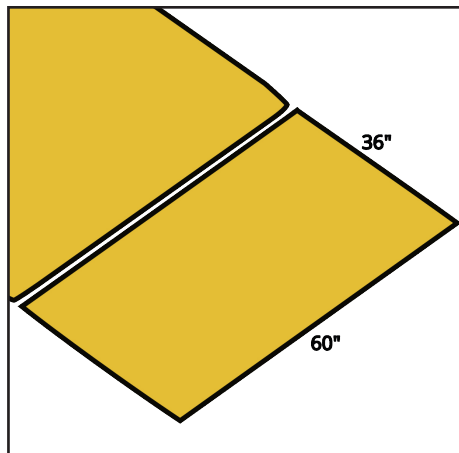


## PREPARE THE CLOTH

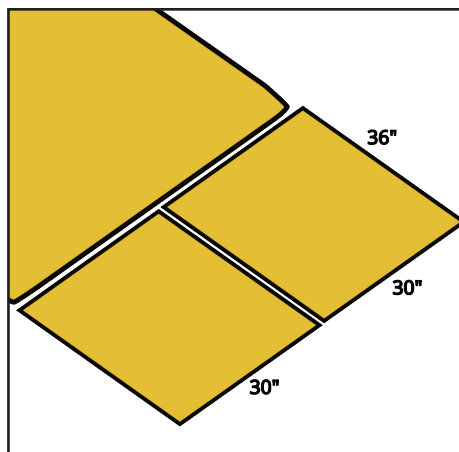
Measure 36" of fabric from the bolt and mark the cloth with a pencil.



Cut the cloth along this mark, you should end up with a 60"x36" square of cloth.



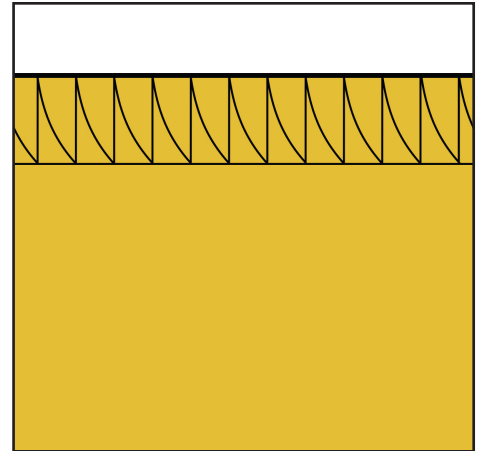
Cut the cloth in half along its longest dimension, resulting in 2 30"x36" squares of cloth.



Set one of the squares of cloth aside for the next Flag.

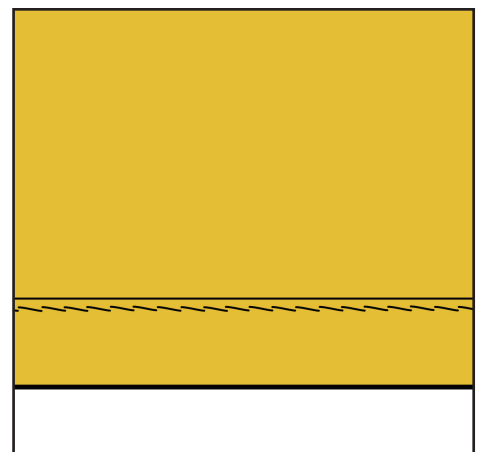
## STRENGTHEN THE CLOTH

You can optionally increase the durability of the flag by reinforcing its edges, either:



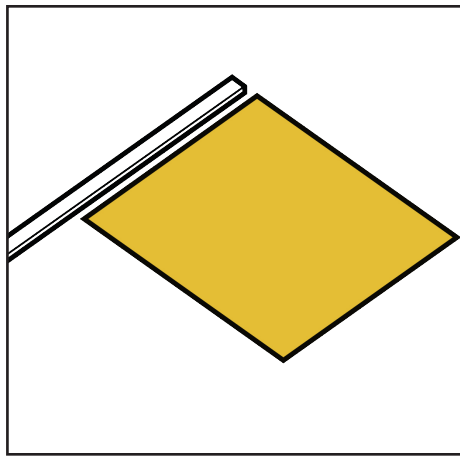
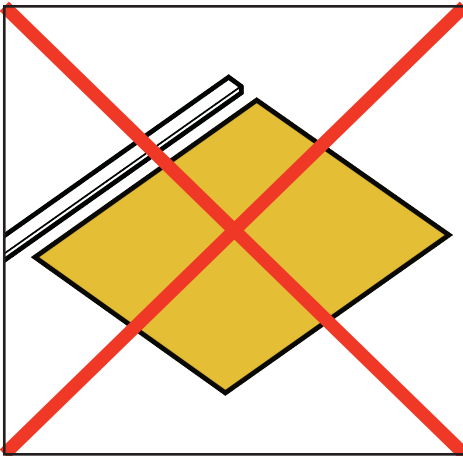
a. serging one or more edges of the fabric (a mock overlock stitch can substitute if you do not have a serger)

b. sewing one or more edges of the fabric back onto itself (hemming)

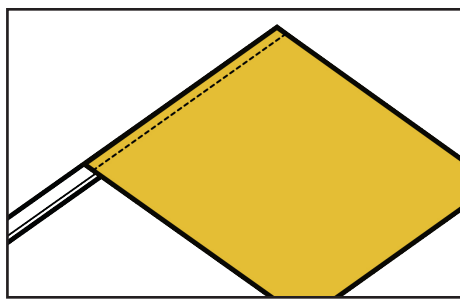
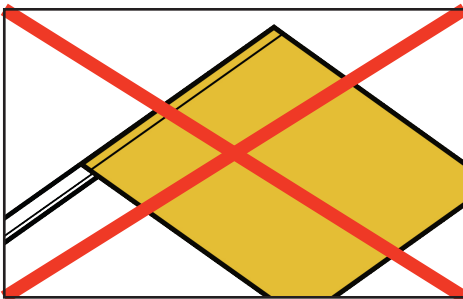


The most important edge to reinforce is the top edge (one of the 36" edges). The other 2 non-staff-facing edges can be helpful to reinforce as well. The staff facing edge does not need reinforcement because we will later fold the cloth over to strengthen it.

**ATTACH THE CLOTH TO THE STAFF**

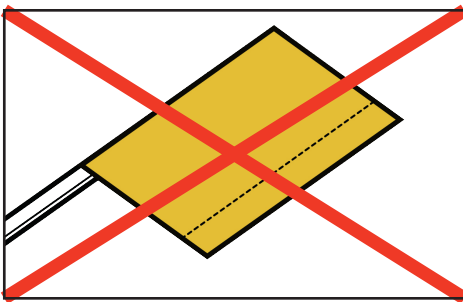


Lay out the staff on the ground alongside your cloth. The short side of the fabric should be against the staff.

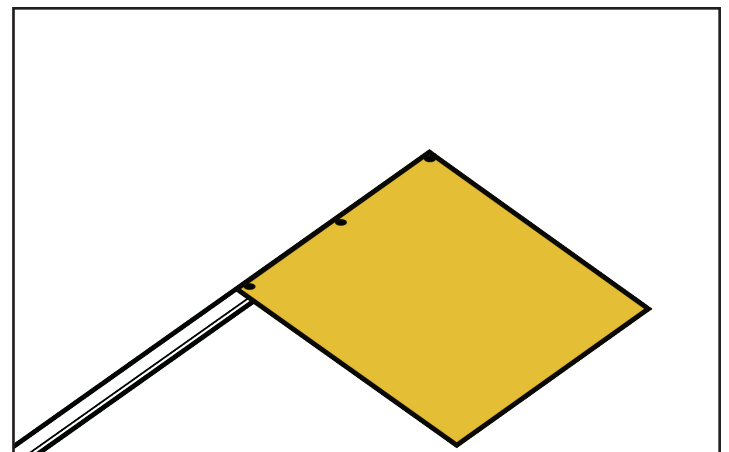
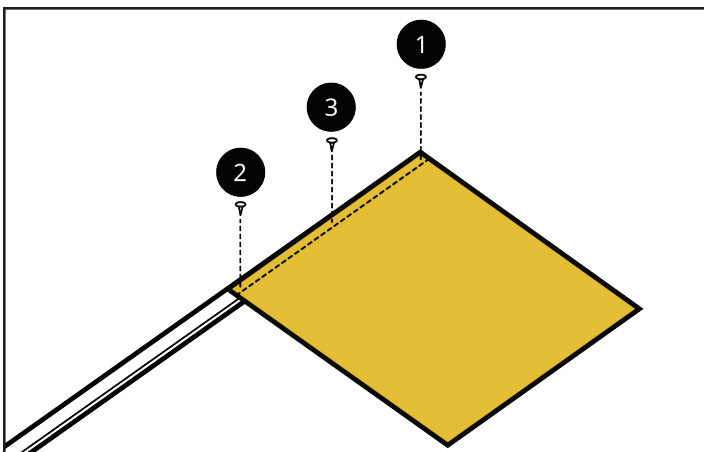


On the staff-side of the cloth, fold the fabric back by approximately 1.5 inch and lay the fabric over the staff. The shorter side of the folded fabric should be facing the staff, hiding the fold from onlookers.

Be sure to stretch the cloth taut along the staff



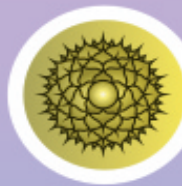
In the order of top, bottom, middle, hammer the cloth to the staff using the tacks.

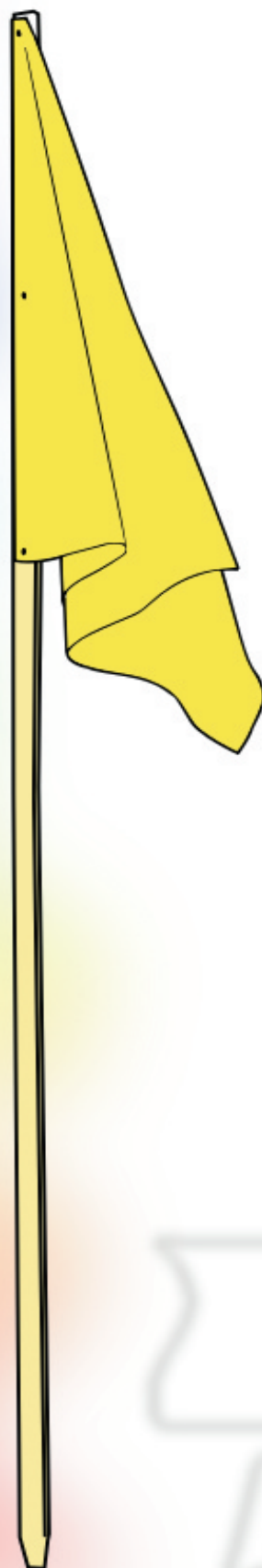

The Tip of the Flag is the Vexillarium, The Golden Crown. This is the material spiritualism of the Flag

The First nail is the command Chakra, the center of energy at which Flag guru initiation happens

The second nail is the emanation point of the Flag, and is represented by sodium. It is the lotus petal of enjoyment

The Third nail is the Vexillicrocus, or Heart of the Flag. This is the spiritual materialism of the Flag.

The seat of the left hand on the pole just below the fabric is associated with yellow iron pigments

The seat of the right hand, the lower part of the pole, is associated with the anti-microbial

The Butt or Point of the Flag is the dirty part. This is associated alternatively with Sulphur or Lead-Tin based on the tradition.

# A Practical Guide to the Chakra Vexillomantia

# TOP SECRET FLAG WISDOM REVEALED!

In a discovery that has captivated scholars and mystics alike, an ancient holy text related to the practice of vexillomancy—the divination through flags—has been unearthed in the windswept dunes of the Gobi Desert. This extraordinary find, dated to at least 7,000 years ago, consists of a long yellow cloth, inscribed with cryptic symbols that, despite their visual obscurity, have been at least partially psychically translated by a team of researchers.

The discovery was made by a team of archaeologists and survey members, lead by Tu Qi Zhen, conducting an expedition in the southeastern regions of the Gobi Desert. Buried under layers of sand, the cloth remained remarkably preserved due to the arid conditions. The Gobi Desert has been a site of historical convergence for nomadic peoples, merchants, and spiritual seekers traveling along the Silk Road. Researchers speculate that this yellow cloth could have been a ceremonial object, used in ancient rites to foretell significant events, convey divine messages, or manipulate the weather. The combination of the cloth's color and the cryptic writing suggests it held special significance in vexillomantic traditions, potentially as a medium between human and divine realms.

Unable to make sense of the symbols through traditional means, the research team turned to an unconventional method—psychic translation. Drawing on the expertise of vexillomancers trained in ancient languages and cultural energies, the team attempted to decode the meaning of the text through intuitive impressions rather than intellectual deciphering.

Although first attempts at recovering the content left many researchers in a state of "flag psychosis"

convinced that the text simply said the word "FLAGS" repeatedly, new progress has been made. According to the lead translator, the meta features of the symbols conveyed "a stream of consciousness, imbued with cosmic reverence for cycles of birth and death, change and constancy." The yellow flag was described as a bridge between worlds, both a warning of impending transformation and an invitation to accept the unknown. "It speaks of a sky filled with invisible flags, fluttering in winds that are the breath of unseen beings," said one researcher. "Each fold in the cloth mirrors the folds of time itself."

The text, though fragmentary in this translated form, is believed to be a guide to interpreting the will of the heavens through the movement of flags. Specific movements of yellow flags, as dictated by desert winds, were considered sacred signals, offering insights into the fates of entire communities.

Further study is needed to fully understand the implications of this text, but the discovery is already reshaping how historians view ancient desert cultures.

The combination of vexillomancy, psychic translation, and sacred cloth indicates a highly evolved spiritual system, one that blended physical symbols with metaphysical insight.

The research team plans to continue investigating the site where the cloth was found, hoping to uncover more artifacts or contextual evidence that might explain the origins of this mystic practice. Meanwhile, the yellow cloth itself has been placed in a specialized preservation chamber, where experts in ancient fabrics and symbols will continue to examine its physical properties.

In an exclusive deal with the researchers we have obtained access to translations of a few select fragments of the text which span the next few pages, accompanied with psychically generated artwork that may have accompanied the texts.

Flag consciousness, as it were, is the ineffable awareness of the chromatic particularity of certain banners. It is not mere perception, nor is it a product of cultural conditioning or cognitive processing. Rather, it is an intuitive recognition of the essence of flagness, which transcends any empirical or epistemological framework.

Some have attempted to reduce flag consciousness to a simple matter of color recognition, as if it were a mere matter of visual processing. But this reductionism fails to capture the full richness and complexity of flagness. 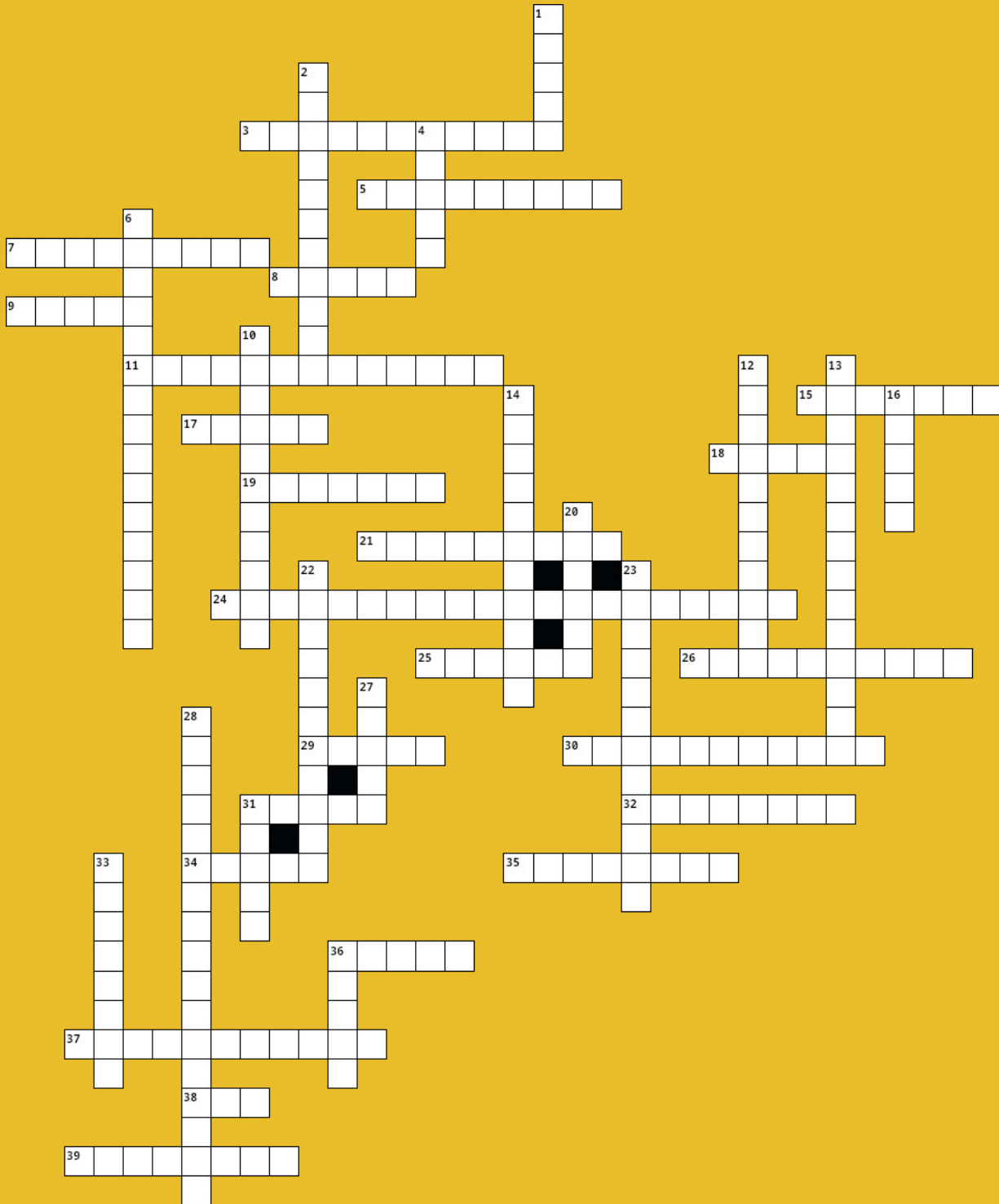

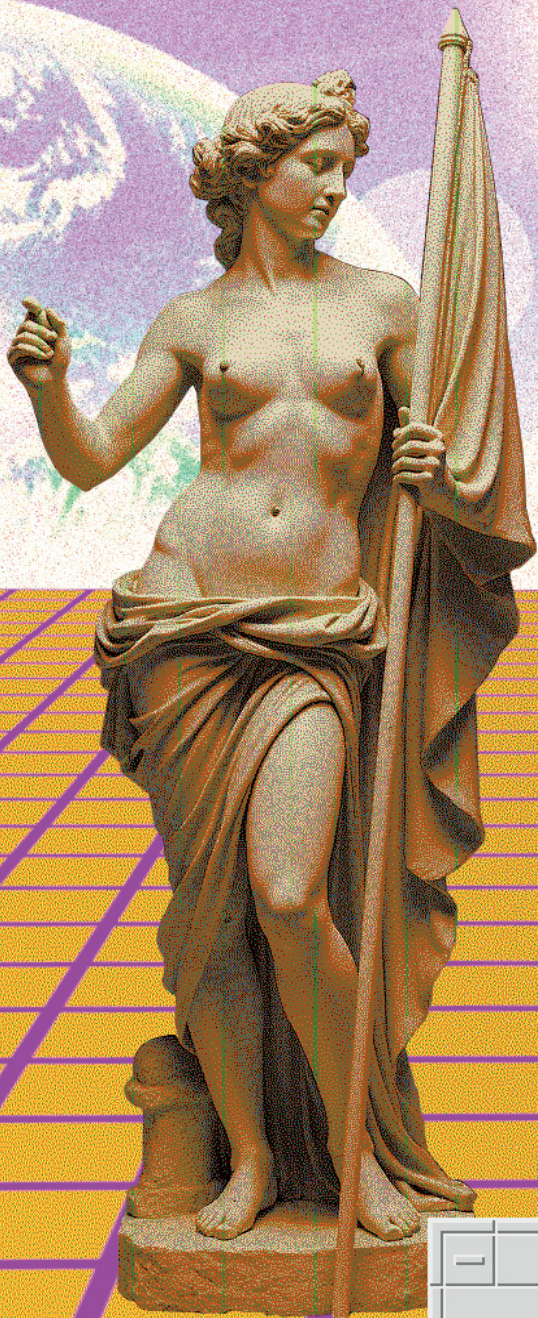

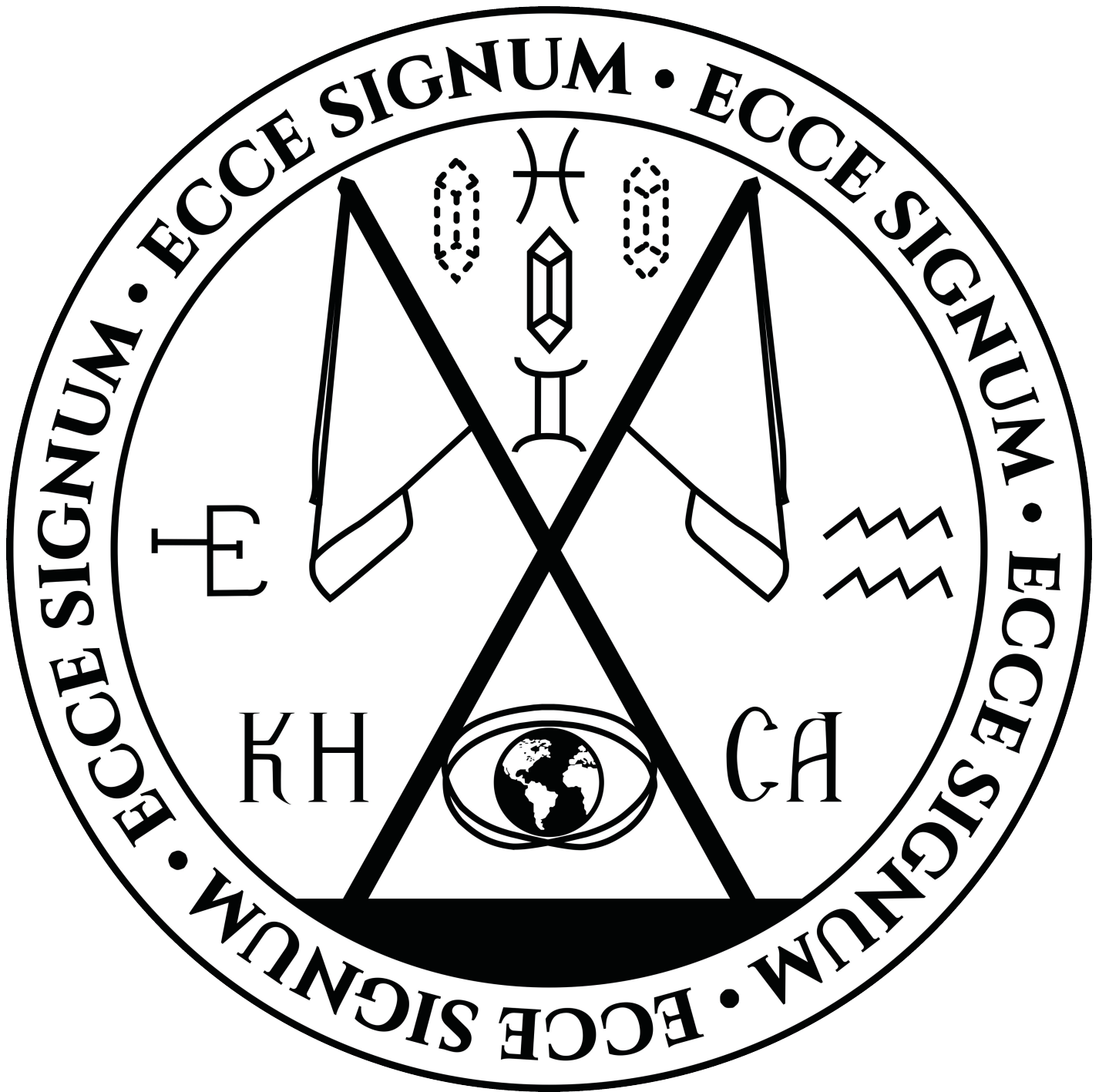
